

MASADA COLLEGE ENROLMENT POLICY

Policy

Masada College is open to all Jewish students and to non-Jewish students provided places are available.

The College does not discriminate with regard to enrolments on the basis of gender, disability, or additional learning support needs. However, the College may not be able to accommodate all children given the limitation of space, number and specialised facilities.

The enrolment process is necessary for new students and ex-Masada students reentering the school.

An application can only be processed once an Application for Enrolment Form has been completed, signed by both parents and the application fee of \$150 for local students and \$300 for International students is paid. This application fee is non-refundable.

Procedures

- All applications will be processed within the College's enrolment policy.
- Consider each applicant's supporting statement / interview responses regarding their ability and willingness to support the College's ethos.
- Consider each applicant's educational needs. To do this, the College will need to gather information and consult with the parents / family and other relevant persons.
- Identify any strategies which need to be put into place to accommodate the applicant before a decision regarding the enrolment is made.
- Inform the applicant of the outcome.

Subject to availability, offers of a place will be made according to the date of application, whether there are siblings of the student already at the school, whether the parents are alumni, if the student is a child of a staff member, as well as the suitability of the applicants. Continuing enrolment is subject to the student's adherence to school rules (see enrolment contract, pastoral care policies and behaviour management policies) and payment of all school fees.
